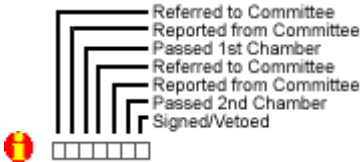

Relates to administrative rules; requires that rules related to occupations under Title 59 receive Legislative approval through the administrative rules omnibus resolution; failure to approve resolution is disapproval of the rule.

occupational licensing.

Relates to administrative rules; requires that any rules that increase fees receive Legislative approval through the omnibus administrative rules resolution; failure of the resolution is disapproval of the rule.
