

Relates to administrative rules; requires that rules related to occupations under Title 59 receive Legislative approval through the administrative rules omnibus resolution; failure to approve resolution is disapproval of the rule.

Remarks: Requires legislature to affirm rules pertaining to

occupational licensing.

HB 1553 Faught, George(R)
Sykes, Anthony(R)

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Relates to administrative rules; requires that any rules that increase fees receive Legislative approval through the omnibus administrative rules resolution; failure of the

resolution is disapproval of the rule.

Remarks: Rules with fees require approval.

Relates to agency rules; declares that all agency rules sunset once every four years; directs a joint Legislative committee to review all sunsetting rules for the year preceding sunset; sets membership and sets meetings during interim.
