Introduction

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- Laboratories accredited to the state program under Oklahoma Administrative Code 252:301 now will be assessed every three years instead of every two.
- The average cost of an assessment for a laboratory under this program is approximately \$1,750. By allowing an additional year between evaluations, laboratories are expected to save an average of \$300 every year.
- The larger the scope of the laboratory, the more cost savings will be experienced from this change.



• Proficiency test (PT) status and the impact to the laboratory's accreditation will now be evaluated and communicated continuously, rather than annually.

 This will enable the laboratory to be more informed and active regarding their accreditation status and analytical performance.



- Quarterly newsletters, recorded trainings, and enhanced guidance will be created and available on the website.
- Expected topics include:

Regulatory changes impacting approved methods and accreditation

Training for PT reporting requirements

Training for use and maintenance of control charts

Improved control chart templates

Training for pH meter calibration and maintenance

• Estimated to have the first quarterly newsletter released in the 4th Quarter of 2023 (October – December).



- Phone and email technical assistance requests are now directed through the entire LAP team.
- This improves response time, consistency, and thoroughness.
- Subject matter experts within the DEQ laboratory are also utilized to provide knowledge and technical expertise for technical assistance requests.
