Summary of Services or Products

Since the inception of Brownfields in 1996, the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality's Brownfields Program has worked with local governments, non-profits and private entities to provide education and support for the cleanup, sustainable reuse, and redevelopment of Brownfield properties. Through this program communities have been able to reinvest in themselves, returning properties in the very core of their infrastructure to beneficial reuse - turning these properties into economic drivers for the community. These projects spur further reinvestment in the community including identification, assessment, and cleanup of other brownfields, ultimately increasing local tax bases, facilitating job growth, preserving historic structures, and taking pressure off undeveloped land. Our goal is to develop, improve, and cultivate an already results-oriented program, while addressing new issues, forming new partnerships, and expanding outreach and education initiatives to assist in the revitalization of communities statewide.
