- Complete the attached Call for Abstracts form in its entirety. SUBMISSIONS MUST BE TYPED OR REPRODUCED ON A COMPUTER IN THIS EXACT ORDER. Handwritten submissions are discouraged.
- All abstracts will be reviewed for acceptance, but those that present a subject matter and content that adheres to the conference theme will be given preferential consideration.
- Review for completeness, accuracy and legibility; sign and date form.
- Limit one idea per form.
- Submit electronically (either Word or PDF) to the email address above.

Each speaker session has approximately 25 minutes: 20 minutes for the presentation and 5 minutes for questions from the audience. **Please ensure your presentation meets this timeframe** requirement as a courtesy to the other speakers in the conference.

## **PROPOSAL REVIEW**

Members of the appropriate Committee or Activities Committee will review all complete proposals. Final selections will be made by the Activities Committee members. Notification of acceptance will be sent to the person noted in the proposal as soon as possible.
